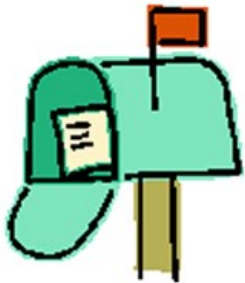
This part of a cell is like a LIBRARY...
